This show put them among artists like the HTP and the MF who have created a certain kind of urban spirituality and wit. He was part of various solo and collective music and art projects focusing primarily on the urban margin. Tends to stay away from the institutional presentation. Likes to view his current artistic production mostly as the Outsider Art.
